

**COMFORTDELGRO ENGINEERING AIMS TO RAISE
\$20,000 FOR CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION**

13 June 2015 – He could have spent this Saturday resting, but Mr Chia Wee Beng, a regional computing facilities manager, has chosen instead to spend it selling items out of the boot of his silver Audi A4 – all for Charity.

Mr Chia, a long-time customer of ComfortDelGro Engineering Pte Ltd (CDGE), joins 19 other SPARK™ Ambassadors in selling groceries and car accessories out of their cars at the Big Splash @ East Coast today. The car boot sale, which starts at 10am and ends at 4pm, is part of the CDGE's charity drive to raise \$20,000 for Children's Cancer Foundation (CCF). Items such as Bosch wipers aero fits, Coke, Hershey chocolate drink and Super cup noodles are sold at discounted prices.

Said the 48-year-old: "I do not mind being a 'salesperson' for the CDGE car boot sale for a day just to raise funds for Children's Cancer Foundation. It's nothing compared to what children with cancer and their families have to go through."

As part of the charity drive, CDGE has also placed 12 donation boxes at its diesel kiosks, as well as SPARK Car Care Centres and taxi maintenance workshops to collect donation from 1 June to 31 July 2015. CDGE staff, ComfortDelGro cabbies as well as SPARK customers have been contributing generously, with about \$2,000 collected so far.
