

COMFORTDELGRO TAXIS FIRST IN SOUTHEAST ASIA TO LAUNCH EURO 6 MERCEDES LIMOCABS

4 May 2015 – Southeast Asia's most environmentally friendly taxis are hitting the Singapore roads this week.

The latest ComfortDelGro Mercedes Limocabs are based on the latest Euro 6 BlueTEC technology and come with Adblue tanks that help reduce harmful emissions by transforming 90% of the nitrogen oxide (NO_X) into environmentally friendly particles such as water and nitrogen. The Euro 6 LimoCab emits only 124g carbon emissions per kilometre (CO₂/km¹), compared to 129g for the Euro 5 and 132g for the older Euro 4 models.

On top of cleaner emission, the new Euro 6 LimoCab is expected to have better fuel efficiency than its predecessor, consuming only about 4.5 litres of diesel per 100 kilometres.

The first batch of 50 Euro 6 Mercedes Benz E220 BlueTEC LimoCabs will be rolled out on 6 May. Two subsequent batches are scheduled to roll out in mid- and end-May, bringing the total number of Euro 6 LimoCabs that the Company will operate to 150, translating into an estimated 20% of the entire limousine fleet.

With its slightly longer and taller body, the Euro 6 LimoCab offers both drivers and passengers with greater headroom and a more spacious interior. Like its predecessor, it has a spacious boot which can accommodate up to three standard golf bags. The Euro 6 LimoCab also features integrated daytime running lights in its front headlamps and full LED lights in its rear lamps.

¹ Carbon emissions refer to the release of carbon dioxide from the use of a vehicle and provide a good indicator of the amount of fuel the vehicle uses. The g CO₂/km is a measure that quantifies the weight of carbon dioxide (CO₂) released for every kilometre that the vehicle is driven i.e. the vehicle's fuel efficiency. The more CO₂ released over the same distance means more fuel is being used.
